The Solution: IPv6

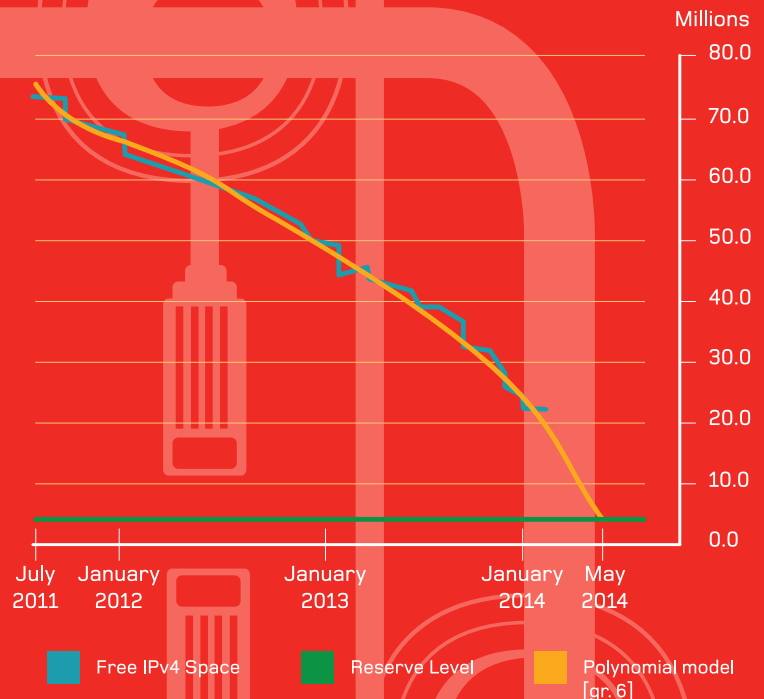
